BENEFITS AND RISKS


The fund provides a simplified option for retirement investing, including professional management, broad-based diversification, and low-cost management fees.

GLIDE PATH



ASSET DIVERSIFICATION**MANAGEMENT**

The Target Funds are managed by Jerome Clark and Wyatt Lee. The portfolio managers are responsible for the strategic design and day-to-day management of the Fund. This includes portfolio design, positioning, performance, and risk-management oversight. The Fund's tactical asset allocation decisions are made by the firm's Asset Allocation Committee. The Committee is chaired by the head of Global Multi-Asset, and includes some of the firm's most senior investment management professionals across major asset classes. Jerome is a member of the firm's Asset Allocation Committee. Individual security selection is made by portfolio managers of the Fund's component strategies drawing on the fundamental insights of T. Rowe Price's team of around 200 global research analysts.

The principal value of the Target Funds is not guaranteed at any time, including at or after the target date, which is the approximate year an investor plans to retire (assumed to be age 65) and likely stop making new investments in the fund. The funds' allocations among a broad range of underlying T. Rowe Price stock and bond funds will change over time. The funds emphasize asset accumulation prior to retirement, balance the need for reduced market risk and income as retirement approaches, and focus on supporting an income stream over a moderate postretirement withdrawal horizon. The funds are not designed for a lump-sum redemption at the target date and do not guarantee a particular level of income. The funds maintain a significant allocation to equities both prior to and after the target date, which can result in greater volatility.

Morningstar rated the fund 3 and 4 stars among 190 and 156 Target-Date 2050 funds for the 3- and 5-year periods (as applicable) ending 9/30/2018, respectively. The Morningstar Rating™ for funds, or "star rating", is calculated for funds with at least a three-year history. Exchange-traded funds and open-ended mutual funds are considered a single population for comparative purposes. It is calculated based on a Morningstar Risk-Adjusted Return measure that accounts for variation in a managed product's monthly excess performance, placing more emphasis on downward variations and rewarding consistent performance. The top 10% of products in each product category receive 5 stars, the next 22.5% receive 4 stars, the next 35% receive 3 stars, the next 22.5% receive 2 stars, and the bottom 10% receive 1 star.
